On the recommendation of the selection committee, the competent authority may relax all or any of the requirements related to age, qualification and experience in experienced and deserving cases. Higher starting pay may be considered in case of extra meritorious candidate and Salary will be fixed at the time of interview based on the experience of the candidate.
