Facilities Available:

Laboratories: The laboratories of NIPER-Guwahati are equipped with different instruments like Gradient PCR, Florescent inverted microscope, Western Blotting

apparatus, Gel Doc, Mammalian Cell culture facilities etc. The laboratories are supervised by the respective faculties.

Animal House: NIPER-Guwahati provides animal house facilities to its students. The Animal house of NIPER-Guwahati is supervised by Dr. Pavan Kumar Samudrala, Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology, NIPER-Guwahati

Computer Lab with Internet: The computer centre at NIPER-Guwahati caters to the need of the students, faculty and staff in their research activities and reviewing their research related literature. We are maintaining LAN facility consisting of 20 desktops with Windows environment. A campus-wide gigabit-ethernet local area network (LAN), which uses fiber optic media, makes computing services available across campus. Centre is also equipped with a dedicated internet connectivity which allows users to have access to the email, Internet and browse through scientific journals. The computer Centre also manages and administers other services such as Electronic Information Retrieval System, DTP and helps the Institute community by managing computing resources. The computer centre is under the supervision of Mrs. Nijara Sarmah, System Engineer, NIPER-Guwahati.

Library: NIPER Guwahati students have access to a library housing a number of books of different categories. Students are also allowed to access the facilities of the Central Library of the Gauhati Medical College (Mentor Institute).

Hostel and Transportation: The boys and girls of NIPER-Guwahati are accommodated in temporary hostel campuses and transportation facilities are provided from their respective hostels to the Institute. The students can also avail transportation facilities to carry out research work in other research organizations.
